A useful name for a food-focused itinerary near other central sights.

Tempura Kondo / Ginza

Consider this stop when you want a distinctive local dining experience.

Maisen Aoyama / Aoyama

Add it to the shortlist, then compare current prices and dietary choices.

Check opening days and transport before building it into an evening plan.
